The Rolex 24 Hours at Daytona has become a must-watch for sportscar fans in recent years. With the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship going from strength-to-strength, it now has a sizable international following from fans, teams and drivers alike. Make no mistake though, this is very much still an American event, with its own culture and atmosphere.

Fan access is second-to-none. The Rolex 24 features grandstand views that overlook the entire circuit, spectator zones throughout the infield section and up-close garage access allowing fans to watch the teams working on their cars from multiple angles. The racing is always intense, with a grid featuring a mixture of DPi prototype machinery and GT cars from privateer and factory teams.



BATHURST 12 HOURS: 4th - 8th February 2021



The Bathurst 12 Hours is a race that has a huge amount of prestige attached to it now. 2021's race will be the 20th edition and has a lot to live up to after a spectacular event in 2020.

The race sees a huge grid of GT3 and GT4 cars take on Mount Panorama, racing from sunrise through to the early evening. For those trackside it's a visual treat, as the top of the mountain is easily accessible and provides breathtaking views of the cars flying past and the surrounding town below.

For many, the Sebring 12 Hours is still considered a season curtain raiser. Held on the world-famous airfield circuit in Florida, it's a race that pushes cars to their limits. The track surface itself is what separates Sebring from almost every other circuit on the planet; it has never changed, making it an extremely bumpy ride. It may be void of steep hills and sudden drops, but that doesn't mean it's easy for the drivers. It remains one of the most technical circuits in the world.

It makes for a visual treat too. The spectator areas are vast and cover the majority of the circuit. In the right place – such as the outside of Turn 1 – watching the sunset during the 12 Hours has become somewhat of a rite of passage for sportscar fans worldwide.

In 2021 the FIA WEC is also returning to the event for another 'Super Sebring' double-header, meaning two major sportscar races will be on the bill once again, both featuring world class fields of GTs and prototypes.

### FIA WEC 6 HOURS OF SPA-FRANCORCHAMPS: 29th April - 2nd May 2021



The FIA WEC's annual trip to Spa-Francorchamps is considered the dress-rehearsal for the Le Mans 24 Hours by the teams and drivers, as it's usually the final race before the event in France. So, for sportscar racing fans it's an event that shouldn't be missed, with a chance to see all the Le Mans contenders in action at one of the most challenging circuits in the world.

The access to the paddock and circuit is superb for the event. Six hours is just enough time to complete a slow lap of the circuit on foot, allowing you the chance to take in all the vantage points at every corner of the iconic undulating circuit during the race itself.

# MONACO HISTORIC GRAND PRIX: 23rd - 26th April 2021



The 2021 edition of the Monaco Historic Grand Prix is set to be a memorable one. Organised biannually by the Automobile Club of Monaco, it takes place a few weeks before the Formula One Monaco Grand Prix on the full 3.3km layout. The nature of the circuit, which has only undergone minor changes since the inaugural Grand Prix in 1929, makes it a perfect venue for historic racing.

The three-day programme is packed for the Historic Grand Prix, featuring a mix of single-seater and sportscar grids spanning multiple decades, making it a real journey through the storied past of arguably motorsport's most iconic event: the Grand Prix De Monaco.

For the event our hospitality suite is located on the third floor of the Ermanno Palace, which overlooks the start/finish straight and Sainte Devote. Guests will enjoy hot drinks and pastries upon arrival, an all-day bar serving beer, wine and soft drinks, a buffet luncheon, TVs in the suite and a giant screen opposite. Access to the paddock is also possible once racing has finished each day.

MILLE MIGLIA & ITALIAN LAKES: 8th - 19th May 2021



The Mille Miglia is without a doubt one of the most spectacular historic racing events on the planet. It features over 450 cars racing on some of the most scenic roads in Europe from Brescia, to Rome and back again to Brescia. It may not be a truly competitive sportscar event like it was back in the 20th century, but it still boasts a huge entry list with stunning vintage sportscars and a route which features special stages, closed roads and huge crowds lining the street.



Our driving tour takes you through the Champagne and Burgundy regions of France before ascending into the hills of the Jura. We have a stay in Montreux overlooking Lake Geneva before dropping down into Italy for a three-night stay on Lake Garda. From here we enjoy the lake and start of the Mille Miglia itself. We then cross back into Lake Iseo for two nights before heading back to Brescia for the finish of the race and experience the pageantry surrounding the finishers as they cross the line after their 1000-mile journey.

From Iseo we head towards home with three overnight stops before reaching Calais. The first is in the Tamina Valley, the second is an overnight in Alsace as we cross back through Switzerland where a few more passes can be enjoyed. Our final overnight is spent by a lake near the town of Laon.

Over the past decade the Nurburgring 24 Hours has grown from a low-key national event to a huge, international motor race supported by a growing number of major manufacturers. The event sees a 150+ car entry each year of GT and touring cars take on the GP loop of the 'Ring and the Nordschleife in a 26-km combined layout.

In arguably the toughest endurance race of them all, everyone from the factory-supported GT3 teams up front to the small privateers racing near-stock tourers at the back are pushed to the limit and sometimes beyond over the course of the race. The hugely challenging circuit, the endless stream of traffic and unpredictable weather make for a breathtaking contest.

All spectators will have access to the grandstands and paddock located on the F1 circuit, as well as the various spectator areas on the Nordschleife itself. 24 hours gives everyone plenty of time to explore the forestland around the circuit and find some of the most spectacular views in motorsport.

2021 will see the 56th running of the Grand Prix de l'Age d'Or take place at Dijon, and it promises to be another unmissable event.

It will be the first for the new FIA WEC Le Mans Hypercar category, which will see Toyota, Glickenhaus, Alpine and ByKolles do battle with brand new machinery, and Corvette Racing's C8.R, which has already proven its worth in IMSA competition over in the USA. Will it be the car that returns the US-flagged factory team to winning ways after a five-year drought?





2. Your holiday booking A booking will exist as soon as we issue our confirmation invoice. This booking is made on the terms of these booking conditions. When you make a booking, you guarantee that you have the authority to accept, and do accept, the terms of these booking conditions on behalf of your party.

When making your booking for your package holiday we will arrange for you to enter into contracts with the principal(s) or other supplier(s) (e.g. event/inco organise/afiline/ferry company/ accommodation provider) that are providing your travel services, named on your confirmation(s), for whom we act as agent. We are the package organiser, with responsibilities to you as set out in these Booking Conditions.

3. Paying for Your Holiday. When you make your booking, you must pay a minimum non-refundable deposit of £100.00 per person when the cost of the holiday is less than £1000.00 (per person). If the cost of the holiday is above £1000.00 per person, a non-refundable deposit of £250.00 (per person) is required. The balance of your travel arrangements must be paid at least 12 weeks before your departure date. If the deposit or balance is not paid on time, we shall cancel your travel arrangements and retain the deposit. Changes in transportation/fuel costs or exchange rates & taxes mean that the cost of your travel arrangements may change after you have booked.

4. If You Cancel Your Holiday You, or any member of your party, may cancel your travel arrangements at any time. Written notification from the person who made the booking must be received at our offices. Since we incur costs in cancelling your travel arrangements, you will have to pay cancellation charges as follows:

We will not be liable where any failure to perform or improper performance of the travel services is due to: the behaviour of you or another member of your party, or a third party unconnected with the provision of the travel services in the package, and that is unforeseeable or unavoidable; or unavoidable; and extraordinary circumstances, which means a situation beyond our control, the consequences of which could not have been avoided even if all reasonable measures had been taken.

You agree to accept that in those circumstances the alternative ATOL holder will perform those obligations and you agree to pay any money outstanding to be paid by you under your contract to that alternative ATOL holder.
